With SocialBox you get an absolutely easy to use Wordpress Plugin which enables you to add a sleek social widget to your WordPress site or blog. It displays the current numbers of Facebook likes, Twitter followers and YouTube Channel and Feedburner feed subscriptions. You can enter default values which will be shown if the related api is not reachable.

Installation

To install this plugin into WordPress, simply use the built in installer.

Go to "Plugins > Add new", choose "Upload" and select the file *socialbox.zip* which is provided within this download.

Widget Settings

Social Accounts

If you want to hide one of the networks leave its field blank.

Facebook

Enter your (pages) Facebook ID (e.g. 13274077007) or name (e.g. nettutsplus).

Twitter

Enter your Twitter screenname (e.g. envatowebdev).

YouTube

Enter your YouTube channels name (e.g. nettutsplus).

FeedBurner

Enter your feeds Feedburner name (e.g. nettuts).

Default Values


Enter the default values. These will be displayed if the related api is not reachable.

Additional Settings

Show Buttons

Check this option if you want to display the larger Follow / Subscribe buttons.
