Installation Guide

Requirements:

- Facebook developer account
- SSL certificate
- You should have PHP and MySQL installed on your server (PHP 5+)
- Installed WordPress (<http://wordpress.org/download/>)

1.Getting started

To install this theme you must have a working version of WordPress already installed. For information in regard to installing the WordPress platform, please see the WordPress Codex -

http://codex.wordpress.org/Installing_WordPress

2.Installing the theme

After you finish setting up your WordPress installation, you have to install this theme. You can do it in two ways:

FTP Upload: Unzip the "*timeline.zip*" file and upload the contents into the `/wp-content/themes` folder on your server.

Wordpress Upload: Navigate to **Appearance > Add New Themes > Upload**. Go to browser, and select the zipped theme folder. Hit **"Install Now"** and the theme will be uploaded and installed.

Once the theme is uploaded, you need to activate it. Go to **Appearance > Themes** and activate your chosen theme.

3.Setting up theme options

After activating theme, navigate to **Plugins > Add New**. In search field type "**option framework**". In search results install and activate the first plugin result **Option Framework** by Devin Price (<http://wordpress.org/extend/plugins/options-framework/>).

Navigate to **Appearance > Theme Options**

3.1.General Settings

In this area you can select theme color scheme, choose scroll effect, enable/disable scroll effect on mobile devices (I recommend to disable scroll effects on mobile for 2 reasons. First effects require more CPU power. Second scrolling on touch mobile devices works differently), upload logo (must be 200x100px), activate footer and add social links.

3.2.Immage Slider Settings

In this area you can activate header slider, select his height on home page and other pages (if you want do disable slider from all other pages except home page set "**add inner page slider height**" field to 0), choose slider effect and enable/disable auto play slideshow

3.3.Background Slideshow Settings

In this area you can activate background slideshow, set delay between slides, select background overlay.

3.4. Background Video Settings

In this area you can activate background video, select image (which is shown until video is buffered), select mp4 video and ogv video.

4. Setting up menu

Go to **Appearance > Menus** and you will see a panel where you can create new menus. Create one, add your created pages to it (from the left side panels) and save it. After this, in the left side you have a drop down box where you can select the Primary Navigation. Choose your newly created menu, hit **"Save"** and you're all set.

5. Adding content

5.1. Adding Posts

1. Go to **Posts > Add New**
2. Enter a title and some content
3. Select a post category
4. Click on **"Set featured image"** to upload a preview image for this post (this is not necessary). Once the image is uploaded, click **"Use as featured image"**.
6. After dealing with all content you can customize the post

In Content Settings section you can select content position, show or hide title, show or hide category and comments panel and show or hide social icons.

In Image Settings you can select 3 different image styles, select image position (Important! If you want image to be in the opposite side of the content you have to select opposite position of content position), select image size, select image badge (I have included PSD badge files if you want to change them), add image title (Important! If you add image title you will switch to "image content mode" which disable full size link), add image content (Important! If you add image content you will switch to "image content mode" which disable full size link), add button link, add button title and add more than one image which will activate image slider (Important! Your post has to have **"featured image selected"**).

I encourage you to experiment with different settings there are lots of possible combinations

5.2.Adding Pages

The process of adding pages is quite similar to adding posts
If you want to add contact us page just select template "Contact Form" from Page Attributes panel. Messages from this form will be send to admin e-mail address.

5.3.Adding posts to Home page

Home page will display only "sticky" posts so if you want to display post to home page select "Stick this post to the front page" from publish settings for each post.

page.php - page template

single.php - post template

sidebar.php - sidebar template

options.php – functions for option framework plugin (theme settings)

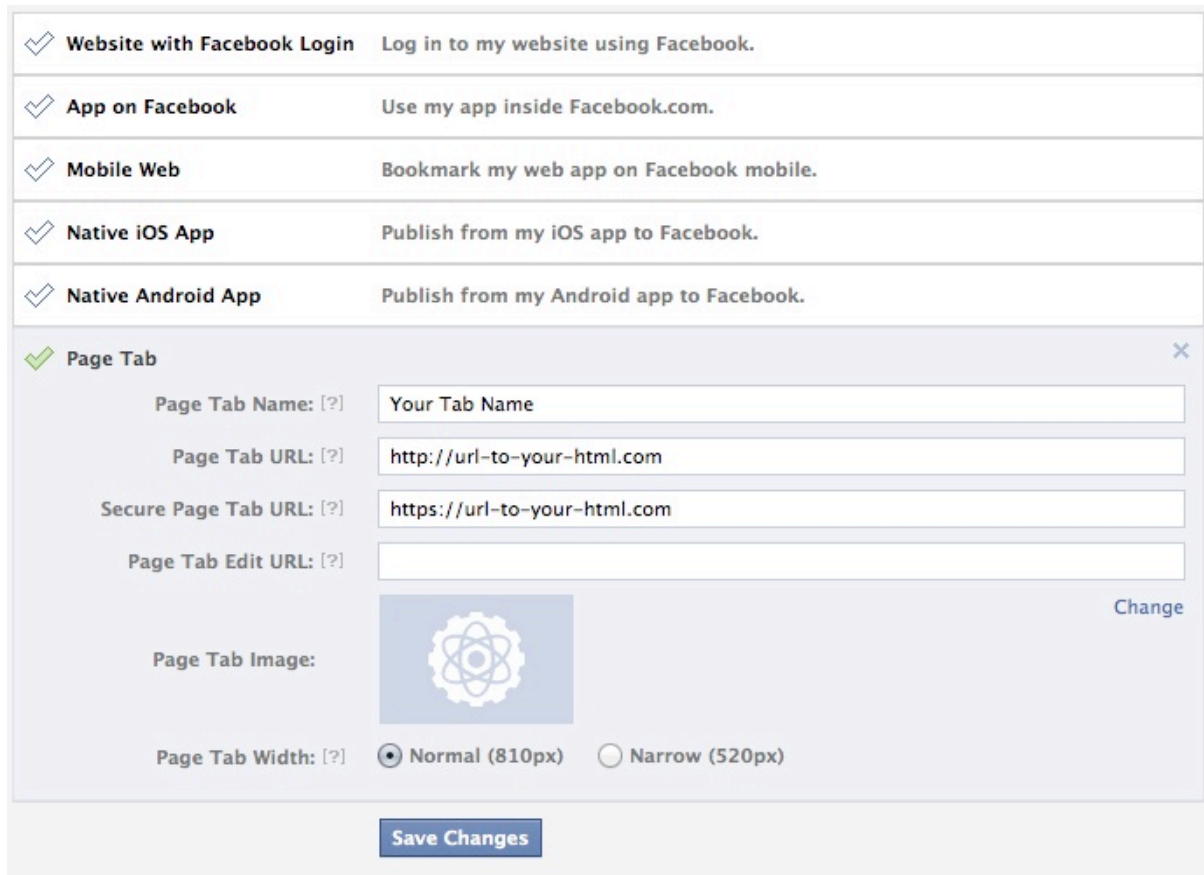
functions/ add_meta_box.php - functions for post and page settings

1. Go to <https://developers.facebook.com/apps>
2. Click on "+ Create New App"
3. Add your App Name
4. Add your Page Tab Name, Page Tab URL and Secure Page Tab URL (see img)
